What will my health coverage cost?

The exact cost depends on your age, where you live, the type of plan you choose, and your household income.

Depending on your income, you may be able to save on your premiums and out-of-pocket costs. You'll find this out when you enroll through the health care marketplace (Washington Healthplanfinder).

When and how can I enroll?

You can sign up during open enrollment from November 1 to January 15. (Some people may qualify for special enrollment periods. Go here for more information: individualandfamily.chpw.org/individual-and-family-plans/eligibility/special-enrollment-period/)

Will I be able to keep my doctor(s)?

We have more than 260 clinics, 1,500 primary care providers, 5,300 behavioral health specialists, and 10,400 medical specialists in our statewide network. Go here to look up a doctor: individualandfamily.chpw.org/find-a-doctor/



Which plan is right for you?

Depending on your income, you may qualify for savings such as Cascade Care Savings, which lower the cost of your monthly premium, and cost-sharing reductions, which lower the amount you pay out of pocket for health services.

Gold

These plans cover 80% of the cost of care. They qualify for Cascade Care Savings.

If you go to the doctor or use prescriptions often, a Gold plan may be a good fit.
These plans cost more per month (higher premium) but cover more of the cost when you need care.

Silver

These plans cover 70% of the cost of care. They qualify for Cascade Care Savings.

You may want to choose a Silver plan if you regularly use your coverage and qualify for premium or out-of-pocket cost savings.

Bronze

These plans cover 60% of the cost of care. They do not qualify for Cascade Care Savings.

If you rarely go to the doctor or use prescription drugs often, a Bronze plan may be a good fit. These plans cost less per month but cover less of the cost when you need care.
